Substitute Trails Day Work Form

In order to qualify for End-of-Season Points you must participate in the scheduled ACC Trails Day or a substitute trail work project hosted by Roaring Fork Outdoor Volunteers, Town of Snowmass Village, Roaring Fork Mountain Bike Association, or similar organization. The project must be within the Roaring Fork drainage or Glenwood / New Castle area and must be hosted by a recognized organization (sorry, doing trail work on your own does not count).

Qualifying Projects

- Any RFMBA, RFOV or similar organization's trail work project between May 1 and the final cutoff date below. Please see the RFMBA, RFOV and other websites for scheduled trail work projects. It is your responsibility to sign-up with the sponsoring organization.

ACC Participant...

- **It is your responsibility to fill out this form and have it signed by your work party supervisor after completion of your work. You must bring this form with you to the project.**
- A minimum of 3 hours of trail work are required to qualify for your Trails Day points.
- Trails Day or substitute project participation is required for eligible for end of season points and awards (this includes junior members).
- To submit your form you must email a photograph or scan of your signed form to results@aspencyclingclub.org
- You must submit this form within 7 days of performing the work or by the final cutoff date, whichever occurs sooner.
- **The final cutoff to submit work forms is 8:00 PM Sunday, August 27, 2023. Forms will not be accepted after that time – no exceptions.**
